Susan is a graduate of UC Berkley and received her Ph.D. from Scripps Inst. An Author of 4 books the most recent is about Charles Richter. Susan has 3 children and has resided in South Pasadena since 1997. She explained the difference between prediction

and forecasting, the latter can calculate, expect and anticipate earthquakes and make us become more prepared and improve building codes to help minimize damage and loss of life. Predicting is another story, some believe animal behavior, moon phases and clusters

of foreshocks will someday show us how to predict. Charles Richter said only fools and charlatans can predict earthquakes. The San Andreas Fault has had major quakes in central and northern California but it's been 300 years since one in the south.
